- N-TEXX Soil Inoculant with Humus - 1097
- Waste Away - 1096

Congratulations, we have determined all your products comply with Chapter 16-160 WAC and National Organic Standards; no additional information is needed at this time. The enclosed registration certificate is valid through October 31, 2014 and may be used to demonstrate your product's approval status.

Your products will also be included on the WSDA Brand Name Material List, which is published in an electronic form on a monthly basis. This list is included as a resource in certification packets sent to the 1,200 farms and handling companies certified by our agency to produce organically labeled crops or products. REMINDERS:

Please note the following important items regarding registration of materials for organic production.

1. Once registered, you must renew your products registration on an annual basis. In August you will be mailed your renewal registration packet. This paperwork, and your annual

registration fee, will be due September 15. Applications postmarked after October 31st will be charged a late fee of \$100 each month past due.

2. Any changes to formulations, ingredient suppliers, or manufacturing facility and manufacturing process, must be reported to our office and approved prior to implementation.
3. All labels making reference to WSDA's registration of your product must be approved by our office PRIOR to sale, distribution, or representation.
4. Requests for registration of new products are welcome anytime. New product applications may be requested in hardcopy by contacting our office or can be found online at: <http://agr.wa.gov/FoodAnimal/Organic/MaterialsLists.aspx>
5. Inspections of the manufacturing facility or samples of your products may be taken throughout the year. These inspections may be scheduled inspections or unannounced inspections. WAC 16-160-180
